



User manual for Translation Add-On

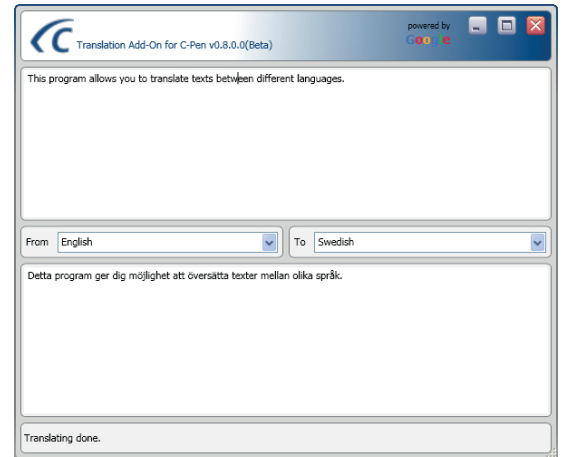
The Translation Add-On is an online program, powered by Google, for translating texts between different languages. The Translation add-on is free. With the Translation Add-On you simply select which languages you want to translate to and from, scan with C-Pen and the translation instantly pops up.

Installation

You can get this Add-On by either downloading it directly from our website at www.cpen.com/applications or through the C-Pen Core application on your computer.

Starting the Add-On

Double click on the Translation Add-On icon on your desktop or select the user profile made for the translation Add-On in the C-Pen Core application.



Using the Add-On

1. Start C-Pen Core (if not already started)
2. Start the Translation Add-On and select languages.
3. Scan text with C-Pen. The translation is instantly presented.

NOTE: This is a online translation service, and therefore requires an internet connection.

Supported languages (both directions):

Afrikaans, Albanian, Armenian, Azerbaijani, Basque, Belarusian, Bulgarian, Catalan, Croatian, Czech, Danish, Dutch, English, Estonian, Finnish, French, Galician, German, Greek, Hungarian, Icelandic, Indonesian, Irish, Italian, Latvian, Lithuanian, Macedonian, Malay, Maltese, Norwegian, Polish, Portuguese, Romanian, Russian, Serbian, Slovak, Slovenian, Spanish, Swahili, Swedish, Turkish, Ukrainian, and Welsh.

In addition to the supported languages above, it is also possible to translate text to the following languages:

Arabic, Chinese (Simplified), Chinese (Traditional), Filipino, Georgian, Haitian Creole, Hebrew, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Persian, Thai, Urdu, Vietnamese, and Yiddish.

(Note: These languages can not be used as scan language.)

Tips & tricks

- To translate continuous text, just keep scanning. The translation will update automatically.
- Double-click the C-Pen function button to start again with a completely new text. The previous text is selected and the new scan will replace it.
- If you have minimized the Translation Add-On window, a new scan will automatically bring-up the program. You can also click the CTRL key twice on your keyboard to bring it up.
